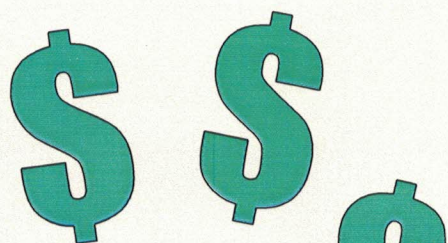

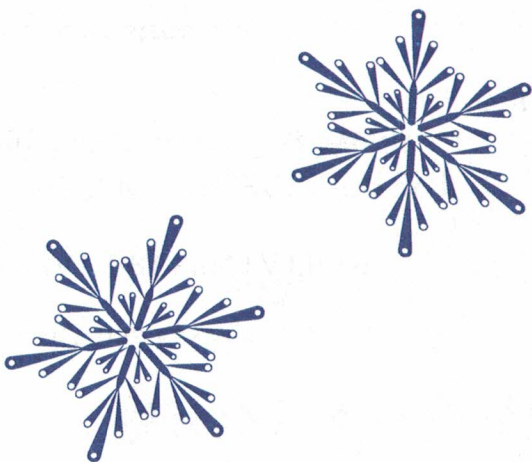
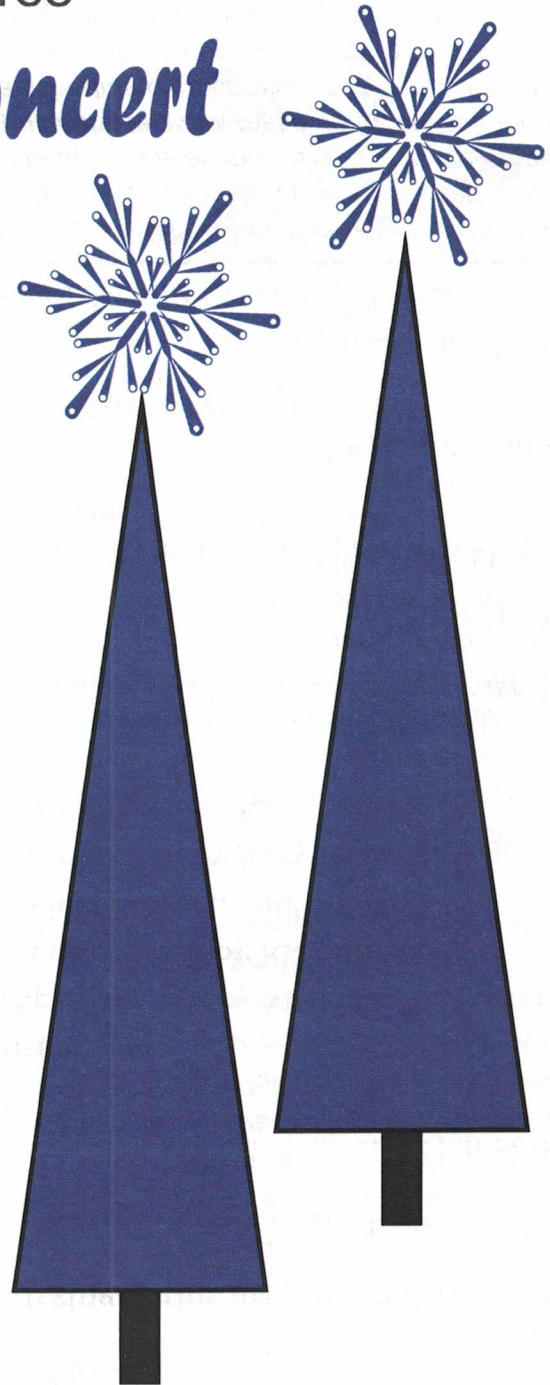

MCSB loses beloved founding member, bassoonist Sylvia Hall

Sylvia Campbell Hall, 63, of Ridgeland passed away Tuesday, October 20, 2015.

"Sylvia Campbell Hall was one of the founding players in the band, when we first started in 2004. She loved the band so much she hosted band Christmas parties in her home for a number of years. She delighted in playing her bassoon with the band, as well as with many other groups in the area, and we all miss her very much."

MCSB Music Director and Conductor David Miller said, "Born in Brookhaven, MS, Sylvia held a master's de-



gree in journalism from Northwestern University and was a freelance journalist and writer, including working in the White House press corps in Washington, D.C., and later at the Clarion-Ledger as a music, arts and fashion writer.

Sylvia played the bassoon in high school and college, held a music degree from Loyola University, and played the bassoon in MCSB, the Magnolia Bassoon Quartet, the Vicksburg Symphony and the Belhaven University Symphony.

She was a member of Northminster Baptist Church in Jackson, the Junior League of Jackson and the Garden Club of Jackson.

Santa plays Tuba with MCSB!



RAYFORD WOODRICK of Madison, MS, was the *entire* MCSB tuba section when Mississippi Community Symphonic Band first started in 2004, according to Music Director David Miller. One of the original three founders of the Mississippi Community Symphonic Band, Woodrick first knew he wanted to play an instrument when he was entering fifth grade.

"My older brother was already playing trumpet in the Meridian High School band, and I wanted to do that, too," Woodrick said.

Starting with trumpet in the fifth grade and moving to tuba in the ninth grade, Woodrick discovered his two passions – playing tuba and playing in bands.

A college varsity football player, Woodrick couldn't march and play football at the same time, so he opted for Millsaps College Symphonic Band and playing in the pit orchestra for musicals.

He is a member of "Windjammers Unlimited," a Circus Band, recording circus music and playing for circus performances in Sarasota, FL for 25 years and "Windjammers Museum Band," a 40-piece band playing an annual concert of circus music at the Museum of the Circus in Sarasota.

He also performs with St. Matthew's United Methodist Church in Madison orchestra; the National Community Band, Loyola University in New Orleans; the Mississippi Swing "Oompah Band," and he plays tuba in the Jackson Banjo Band. He was in the Mississippi Lions All State Band in 1952-53.

A retired member of the United Methodist Clergy, he has been a pastor in Mississippi, Colorado and Wales (Great Britain). He has been editor of the statewide United Methodist newspaper; and a news service director.

After retirement, Woodrick continues to work for about 100 churches in Mississippi United Methodist Conference.

He has led 15 teams to Mexico. He is a Member Emeritus of MCSB board of Directors.

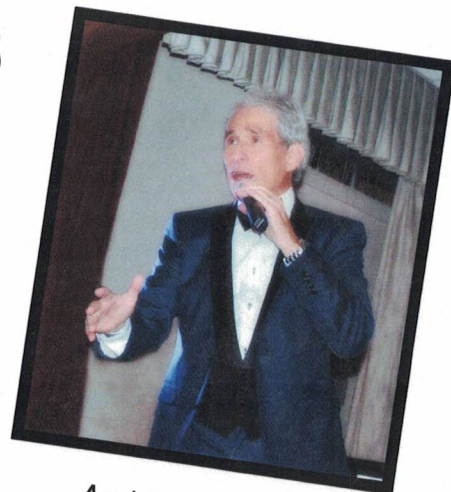
